**ORDER DIRECTING METHOD OF SERVICE OF DISCOVERY**

On this day the Court considered the Trustees' Motion for Court to Direct Method of Service of Discovery ("Motion"). The Court, having considered the Motion, any responses thereto, and the applicable law, is of the opinion that the Motion should be GRANTED. It is therefore:

ORDERED that all parties to this suit are permitted to serve a Notice of Service for all documents served pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 191.5 on each party to this suit in lieu of serving each document served in its entirety. It is further

ORDERED that each Notice of Service contain, at a minimum, the following information: the title of the document or documents served, a link to the full text of the served document at [www.andrewskurth.com/teloffshoretrust](http://www.andrewskurth.com/teloffshoretrust), and the address, including email address, and phone number of Trustees' counsel so that the party served with the Notice of Service may request that a full copy of the served document and/or any documents produced in conjunction therewith ("Document Production") be sent to them after they execute Appendix A of the Agreed Order Protecting Confidentiality ("Protective Order") on file with this Court. It is further

ORDERED that the serving party is not required to serve any Document Production on any party other than the party requesting such discovery, unless the other party specifically requests copies of the Document Production and executes the Protective Order. It is further

ORDERED that the parties have no obligation to publish any Document Production on the aforementioned website. It is further:

ORDERED that, except as to the changes in the process of serving the parties as stated above, the Court's Orders Directing Method of Service of Documents dated September 28, 2015 and January 21, 2016, remain in force and effect.



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
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
