ORDER DIRECTING METHOD OF SERVICE

On this day the Court considered the Attorney Ad Litem's Second Motion for Court to Direct Method of Service of Documents ("Motion") and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A.'s, as Corporate Trustee, and Gary C. Evans, Jeffrey S. Swanson, and Thomas H. Owen, Jr.'s, as Individual Trustees of the TEL Offshore Trust, Opposition thereto ("Trustee's Opposition"). The Court, having considered the Motion, Trustee's Opposition, and the applicable law, is of the opinion that the Motion should be DENIED, in part, and GRANTED, in part. The Motion is DENIED to the extent it asks that the Court eliminate the parties' obligation to serve those parties that cannot be served by electronic means. The Motion is GRANTED to the extent that it requests that the parties have the option to exercise substituted service in a manner that does not require the copying and mailing of each document filed in this matter in its entirety. It is therefore:

ORDERED that all parties to this suit are permitted to serve a Notice of Filing listing each document being filed in this matter on each party to this suit who receives service by mail in lieu of mailing each document filed in its entirety. It is further

ORDERED that each Notice of Filing contain, at a minimum, the following information: the title of the document or documents filed, a brief summary of the relief sought, the time and date of any related hearing, a link to the Travis County Clerk's online document database for this matter, a link to the full text of the filed document at www.andrewskurth.com/teloffshoretrust, and the address, including email address, and phone number of Trustees' counsel so that the party served with the Notice of Filing may request a full copy of the filed document be sent to them. It is further

ORDERED that, except as to the changes in the process of serving parties who are served by mail as stated above, the Court's Order Directing Method of Service of Documents dated September 28, 2016, remains in force and effect.
